RESOLUTION

STATEMENT OF MOTIVES

On July 22nd, 2009, Boy Scout John E. Munoz, a member of Troop 852, will be honored at a special court of honor for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.

This recognition is possible after M. Munoz earned 36 merit badges and completed 122 hours of service. His eagle project entailed building a safety helmet's cabinet for a non-for profit organization named "Horseplay Therapeutic Riding Center", whose mission statement specify that they will provide special-needs children and adult riders in the Tri County areas of Solano, Napa and Yolo an opportunity to improve their quality of life by interacting physically, intellectually and emotionally with the use of horses for therapy.

John is a Vacaville Christian High School freshman and honor roll student. He is also very active with the Ut-In Selica chapter of the Order of the Arrow, which is the Scouting National Honor Society.
