RESOLUTION

To recognize the AMISRAEL organization, its founder and International Director, doctor William Soto Santiago, as well as all the volunteers of the organization for their achievements and efforts in fostering noble causes such as world peace, environmental protection and universal human values.

EXPOSITION OF MOTIVES

AMISRAEL — The Messenger of Peace — is a non-governmental organization with international outreach that works to advance peace amongst peoples and nations. It is a private, non-profit, civic association, educational and socio-cultural in nature, headquartered in Brasilia, the Capital of Brazil. The organization unites people from different countries, races, religions and creeds who identify with the ideals of AMISRAEL, and who are willing to repudiate terrorism and promote peace unconditionally. The entity is managed by its International Director, Dr. William Soto Santiago, who is in charge of representing the organization in all events, and before all governmental and institutional forums.

Through its delegations and volunteers, AMISRAEL organizes and promotes peace-related events and projects in different countries throughout the Americas, Europe, Asia, Africa

and the Middle East. As such, it serves as a catalyst in the solution of all class of problems, whether diplomatic, commercial, cultural or social, that may obstruct the peace process.

As part of these efforts, AMISRAEL organizes a yearly International Conference in Jerusalem. This event has transformed into an independent forum of high-level talks, with diverse tendencies and of great interest to developing and developed nations alike. The theme for this year's activity, to be held in Israel June 7-10, will be "Hope". Here, world leaders will be sharing experiences and proposals regarding different subject areas, all aimed at achieving a better world.

AMISRAEL has been successful in uniting and setting forth common-goal agendas between political, religious and ethnic sectors that usually find themselves at odds. The entity promotes the idea that the solution to a problem can be found in identifying universal values of civilization in individuals who are agents of change.
