RESOLUTION

To extend the warmest congratulations and recognition of the Senate of Puerto Rico to Major General David L. Mann, Commanding General in occasion of his visit to Puerto Rico.

EXPOSITION OF MOTIVES

Major General David L. Mann assumed command of U.S. Army Recruiting Command on February 17, 2011. He is responsible for more than 13,000 Soldiers and Civilians assigned throughout the United States, Europe and the Far East with the primary mission of meeting the Army's recruiting goals. He was designated a Distinguished Military Graduate of Gettysburg College after graduating from Millersville University in 1981. He has served in a variety of command and staff assignments, both in the Continental United States and overseas.

Prior to his current assignment, General Mann served as the Commanding General, 32nd Army Air and Missile Defense Command (AAMDC), a theater- level air and missile defense (AMD) organization responsible for all FORSCOM AMD units, as well as executing operations in support of Operations Iraqi Freedom (OIF) and Enduring Freedom.

Previous staff assignments include: Battalion Logistics Officer, 1st Battalion, 62nd Air Defense Artillery, 25th Infantry Division (Mechanized), Fort Stewart, GA; Operations Research and Systems Analysis (ORSA) officer, Headquarters, TRADOC, Fort Monroe, VA; Assistant Division Air Defense Officer and Battalion Operations Officer, 1st Battalion, 3rd Air Defense Artillery (BSFV/Stinger), 4th Infantry Division (Mechanized) where he deployed to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, as part of JTF 160; ORSA Officer, Directorate of Program Analysis and Evaluation (PA&E), Pentagon; Aide-de-Camp to the Vice Chief of Staff, Army; Senior Planner,

J7 with duty on the OEF Current Operations Team, J-3, the Joint Staff following the events of September 11th; Chief of Staff, U.S. Air Defense Artillery Center, Fort Bliss, TX; Deputy Commanding General, U.S. Army Recruiting Command, Fort Knox, KY.

General Mann holds a Master of Science Degree in Engineering Management from George Washington University and a Master of Arts Degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College. His awards and decorations include the Distinguish Service Medal, Legion of Merit with three Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Iraq Campaigning Medal, Armed Forces Medal, Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, Recruiter Badge and the Joint and Army Staff Identification Badges.
